**CITY AMENDS
STORM WATER PLAN**



Based upon recommendation by the Storm Water Task Force, the River Oaks City Council approved Ordinance # 866-2010 that amends our Storm Water Management Plan by incorporating Section 13.10.017 "Discharge to MS4 Prohibited".

Among other provisions, as of **June 23, 2011**, the Plan will prohibit surface car washes from being conducted on commercial property where there is not a catch basin and interceptor to properly receive the discharge.

The prohibition applies to all car washes regardless of who performs the car wash or whether it is conducted for a fee or not. Businesses should not assume that they have a catch basin and interceptor without verification.

This action is necessary to prevent chemicals and other pollutants from the washed cars from getting into the receiving stream and to reduce the amount of non-storm related drainage flow that is being emitted into the drainageways since the water tends to collect in low lying areas where it becomes stagnant and a public nuisance.

Of course, all of us, not just businesses, contribute these pollutants. As a result, grass clippings, leaves or other debris from yard maintenance that is susceptible to polluting and blocking the storm water drainage system must be removed from the street.

In an effort to promote community wide cooperation, we are asking everyone to observe these newly adopted provisions to do our part in reducing potential water pollution of our waterways.
