



TREE TRIMMING OVER STREETS AND PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAYS

Due to the numerous complaints regarding low hanging limbs over the streets and right of ways that contribute to damages to emergency equipment and other vehicles and also creates traffic hazards; the city is asking your assistance in maintaining these trees to a height of 14-feet above the street and to 7-foot over the right of way which is located in the area approximately 10-feet behind the street curb on your property.

Enforcement of this Article is currently being enforced, however enforcement is not our objective but rather our objective is to have the assistance of all property owners in order to protect the citizens of River Oaks. **For more information please contact the Code Compliance at 817-626-5421, Ext. 314.** Thank you for your assistance in these matters.

Who should trim trees that overhang city streets?
