Approximately 40 people attended the meeting. Hoover and Greenman updated everybody in attendance regarding the improvements for Meandering Road. Currently they are in the design phase studying storm water runoff and infrastructure. The plan on the table is for a 3-lane road with round-a-bout on the west end of Meandering Road. Also included is a bicycle/pedestrian trail to be constructed.


Traffic Counting devices were installed and Geotechnical boring was scheduled to begin the week of November 13th. Small Drilling truck will be at several locations down meandering road. There is funding allocated for this project from the North Central Texas Council of Government. Construction start date is still depending on completion of the design phase.

Several other questions were posed by citizens regarding the project. Hooper and Greenwood invited those in attendance to review the mapping that was present and feel free to ask any other questions. No official action was taken and the meeting closed at approximately 7:20 P.M. without any final remarks from the Mayor or Council in attendance.
