

Feeding Wild Animals is a Violation of the City Code of Ordinances

Sec. 2.06.005 Feeding stray or feral animals

No person shall intentionally place or leave any food or edible item on any public or private property for consumption by stray or feral animals, unless that person is:

- 1) An employee of governmental agency acting in official capacity, or
- 2) A person or agency relocating and/or removing wildlife from public or private property at the City's request.



Present your voter registration card or state-issued ID and show it to your driver. Complimentary service is available for rides to and from voting locations in Tarrant County. Transportation options include **Trinity Metro** (buses, ACCESS paratransit, ZIPZONE services in Mercantile, Near Southside and Crowley), **Tarrant County Transportation Services**, Northeast Transportation Services, and Arlington's Via and Handitran.

Purchased tickets will not be refunded. Those who qualify and want to ride on ACCESS, TCTS, NETS or Handitran should call the provider at least 48 hours ahead of the trip to schedule their free ride to any of the voting locations.

Ballots by mail are available at City Hall or on the Tarrant County website

Just a reminder, if you email or fax the application, you must send the original by mail. We cannot process any request until they receive the original application in the mail.

Tarrant County registered voters are eligible to request and receive a ballot by mail if any of the following conditions prevents them from voting in-person during the early voting period or on Election Day:

- 1. Expected absence from the County during both the early voting period and on Election Day. (The ballot must be mailed to an address outside the County.)
- 2 Disability
- 3. 65 years of age or older
- 4. Confinement in jail and not finally convicted of a felony

You can apply for a Yard Sale Permit by going to City Hall between 8:00am & 4:30pm

Monday—Friday

If you are pulling a permit for a Yard Sale you must meet <u>one</u> of the following requirements:

- 1. You must have an open water account with you as an account holder or authorized user.
- 2. You must have to have the address for the Yard Sale on your government issued ID.
