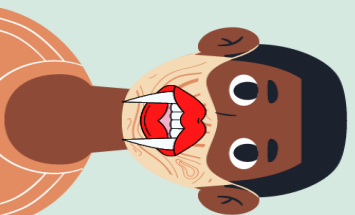

You must present one of the following forms of photo ID when voting in person:

- Texas driver license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS
- Texas personal identification card issued by DPS
- Texas Handgun License issued by DPS
- United States Military Identification card containing the person's photograph
- United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph
- United States Passport (book or card)

Election Identification Certificates are available from DPS driver license offices during regular business hours.

Do not possess and cannot reasonably obtain one of these IDs provided above? Fill out a declaration at the polls describing a reasonable impediment to obtaining it, and show a copy or original of one of the following supporting forms of ID:

- A government document that shows your name and an address, including your voter registration certificate;
- Current utility bill;
- Bank statement;
- Government check;
- or paycheck
- (a) A certified domestic (from a U.S. state or territory) birth certificate or (b) a document confirming birth admissible in a court of law which establishes your identity (which may include a foreign birth document).

After presenting a supporting form of ID, the voter must execute a Reasonable Impediment Declaration.

Present your voter registration card or state-issued ID and show it to your driver. Complimentary service is available for rides to and from voting locations in Tarrant County. Transportation options include **Trinity Metro** (buses, ACCESS paratransit, ZIPZONE services in Mercantile, Near Southside and Crowley), **Tarrant County Transportation Services**, **Northeast Transportation Services**, and **Arlington's Via and Handitran**.

Purchased tickets will not be refunded. Those who qualify and want to ride on ACCESS, TCTS, NETS or Handitran should call the provider at least 48 hours ahead of the trip to schedule their free ride to any of the voting locations.
