AUTOPAY UPDATE

The City of River Oaks City Council has passed the new app for payments. They also approved that if paying online or by the app for utility payments there will be no convenience fee attached; starting when the app comes out.

However, if you choose to pay in person at City Hall by credit card you will be charged a 3.7% fee.

Permits and court payments will have a 3.7% fee online, by app or in person.

You can sign up for auto-payments by credit or debit card and by echeck. If you don't want to sign up for auto-pay you can sign up for payment reminders.

This is more than a payment portal, it also allows access to account information, past payments and bills, as well as water usage. Start service, update account and make service requests right at your fingertips.

Find out more information as it comes available.

This app is in the early stages but we are hoping it will roll out in late April or early May.

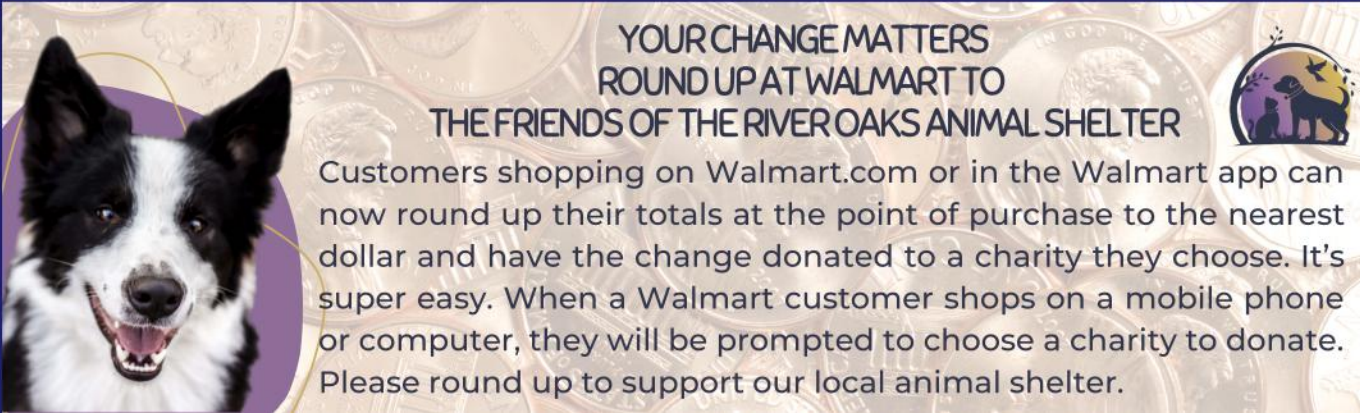
