





THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.



- * Total Proposed Tax Rate = Voter Approval M&O Rate (\$0.616384/\$100) + Debt Rate (\$0.111605) + Unused Increment Tax (\$0.016002/\$100) = \$0.616384/\$100 + \$0.111605/\$100 + \$0.016002/\$100 = \$0.743991/\$100.
