Lawrence Hamilton, Carmen Drake, Tony Scholola and Sally Ellertson with the City of Fort Worth and Jim Amick with Neel-Schaffer were present.


PWD Smith introduced Lawrence Hamilton with the City of Fort Worth. A slide show was presented. The water/sewer lines will be replaced from White Settlement Road to River Oaks Blvd which will take two years to complete and will be done in three phases. They will be installing 24", 12" and 8" water lines and 8" and 10" sewer lines. Phase 1 consists of Churchill Road from White Settlement Road to Doyle Drive which will be scheduled during the summer. Phase 2 consist of Churchill Road from Doyle Drive to Custer Drive. Phase 3 consists of Churchill Road from Custer Drive to River Oaks Blvd. Construction expected to begin November 2019 and projected to end November 2021. Each Phase will last eight months. In some areas, Churchill Road will be open on one side but in some areas, Churchill Road will be completely shut down.
