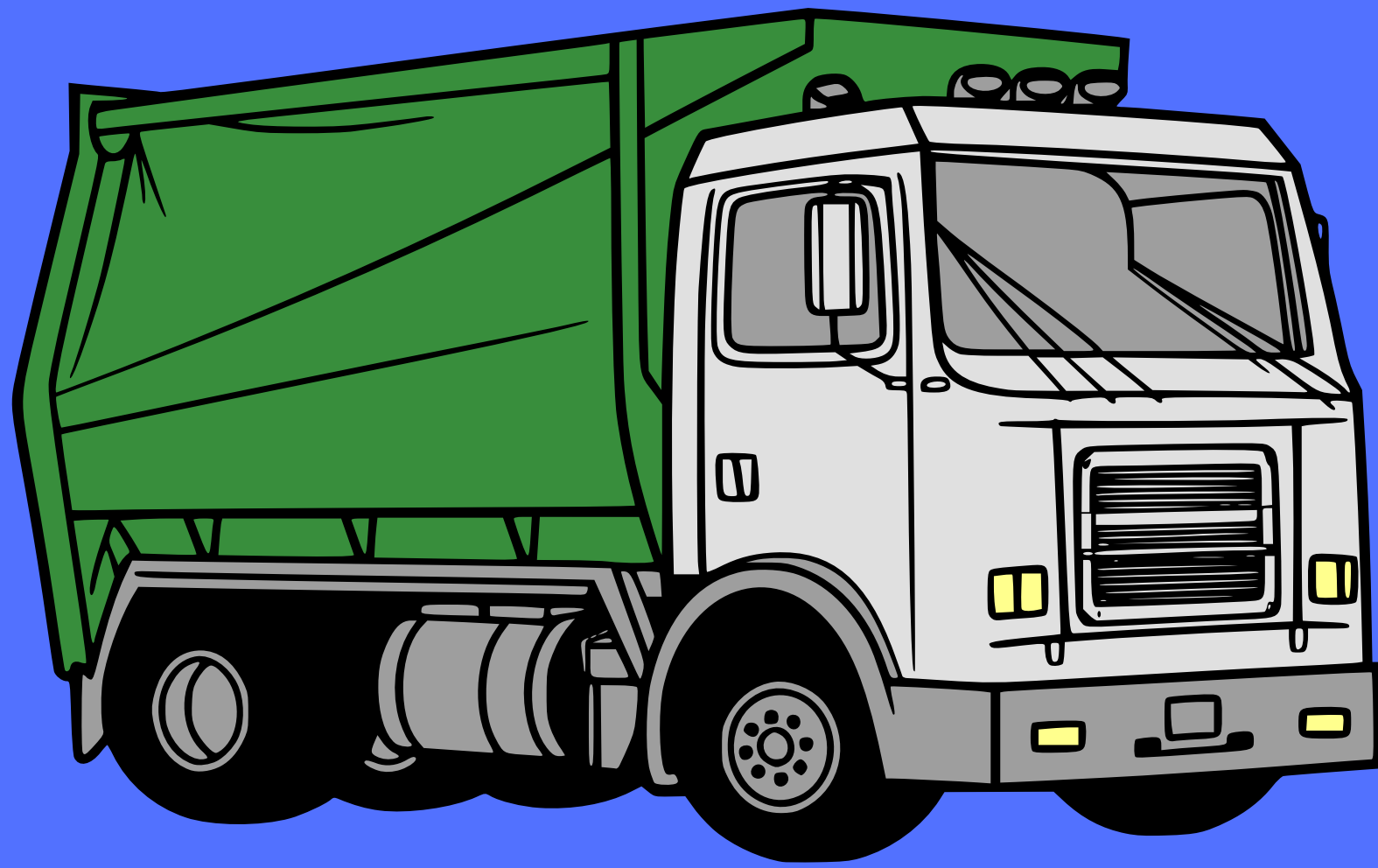

Local governments surrounding the Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Fort Worth have voluntarily formed the Regional Coordination Committee to promote and preserve the military mission at the installation. The Committee is responsible for encouraging compatible land use planning, conducting community outreach, and participating in military affairs surrounding NAS JRB Fort Worth.

Garbage Collection Rate Changes



With a 6.4% landfill increase this year along with increased operational and equipment costs, the present rates charged for residential household collection will not provide sufficient revenues to cover the annual expenditures. Therefore, residential garbage rates will increase \$2.00 per month from \$27.00 to \$29.00 per household plus tax effective November 1st.

With the costs involving street rental uses, dispatching, billing and other administrative fees associated with collection and disposal of commercial dumpsters it necessitates that the city incorporate a 10% monthly franchise fee to the commercial customer to recoup those costs already incurred by the City.

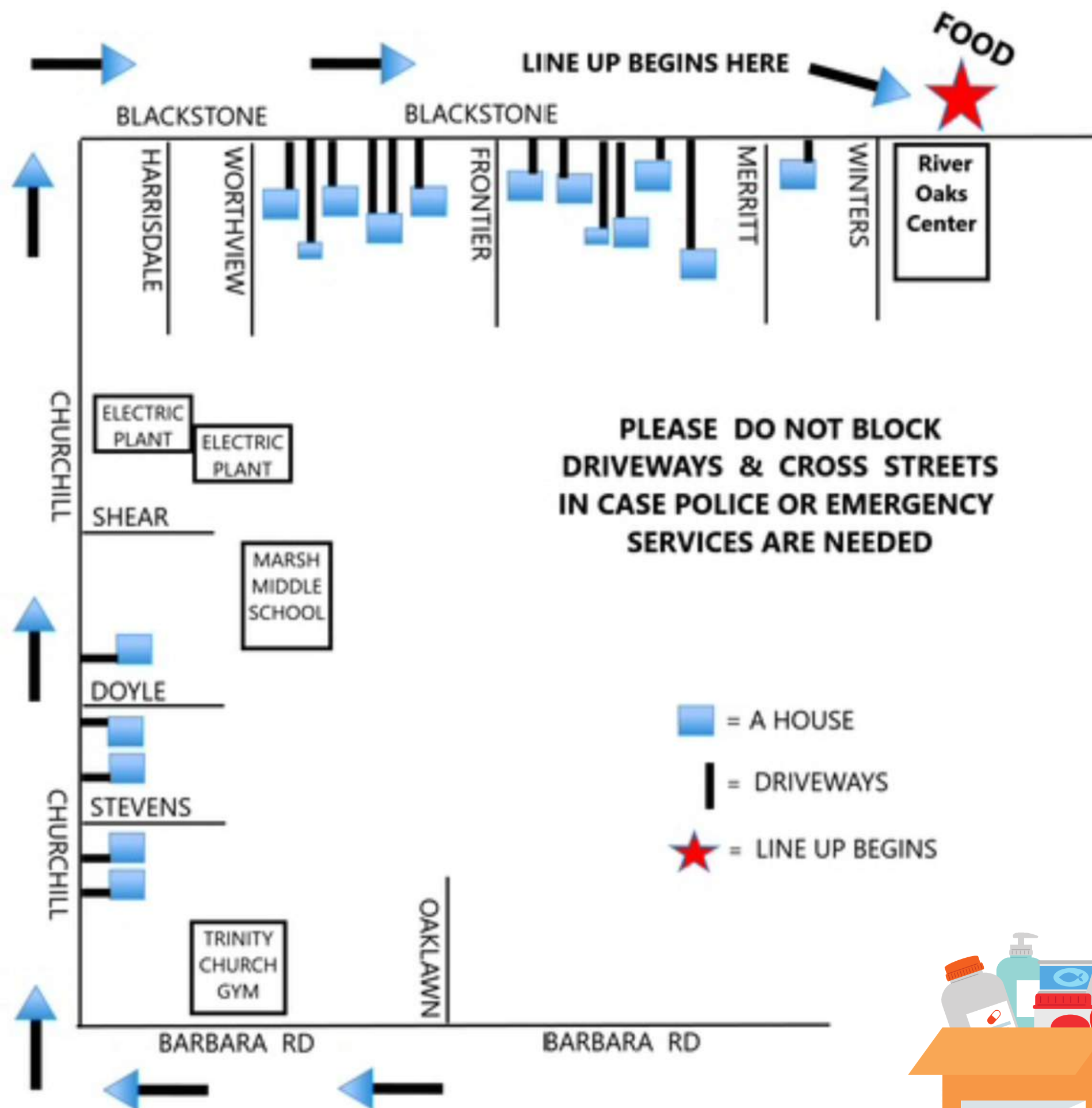
Our Food Banks are held the 2nd and 4th

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YARD SALES

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year. Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You may purchase up to 3 additional directional signs at \$1 each. Signs must be picked up within 24 hours of the end of sale or fines may be issued. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on the ID and the Yard Sale Permit must be purchased 24 hours before the sale. To have your Yard Sale placed in the weekly Newsletter, you must have purchased your Yard Sale Permit prior to 4:30 pm on Thursday the week of your sale.
