Tree Branches



Low hanging tree branches can delay response times of firetrucks during an emergency. These branches can also cause damage to trash trucks, school buses, firetrucks, and other large vehicles.

It is the responsibility of anyone owning, leasing, claiming, occupying, or having supervision or control of any real property; to keep the trees trimmed.

Please us a reputable trimming company, and make sure they measure the trees according to ordinance. ORD: If any portion of the tree or tree limbs are growing at a height less than fourteen feet (14') above the pavement of the roadway or seven feet (7') above the pavement of the sidewalk, or if any portion of the tree or tree limbs are growing in a manner that interferes with or causes an obstruction to motorists using the roadway or pedestrians using the sidewalk.

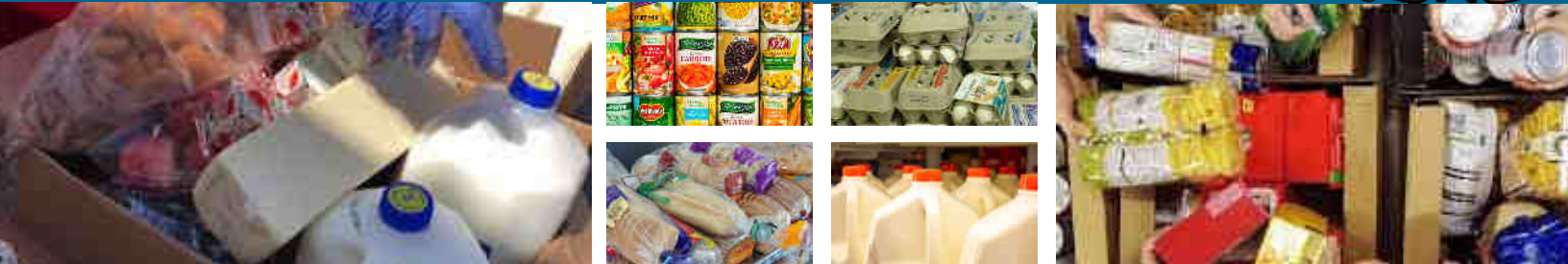
