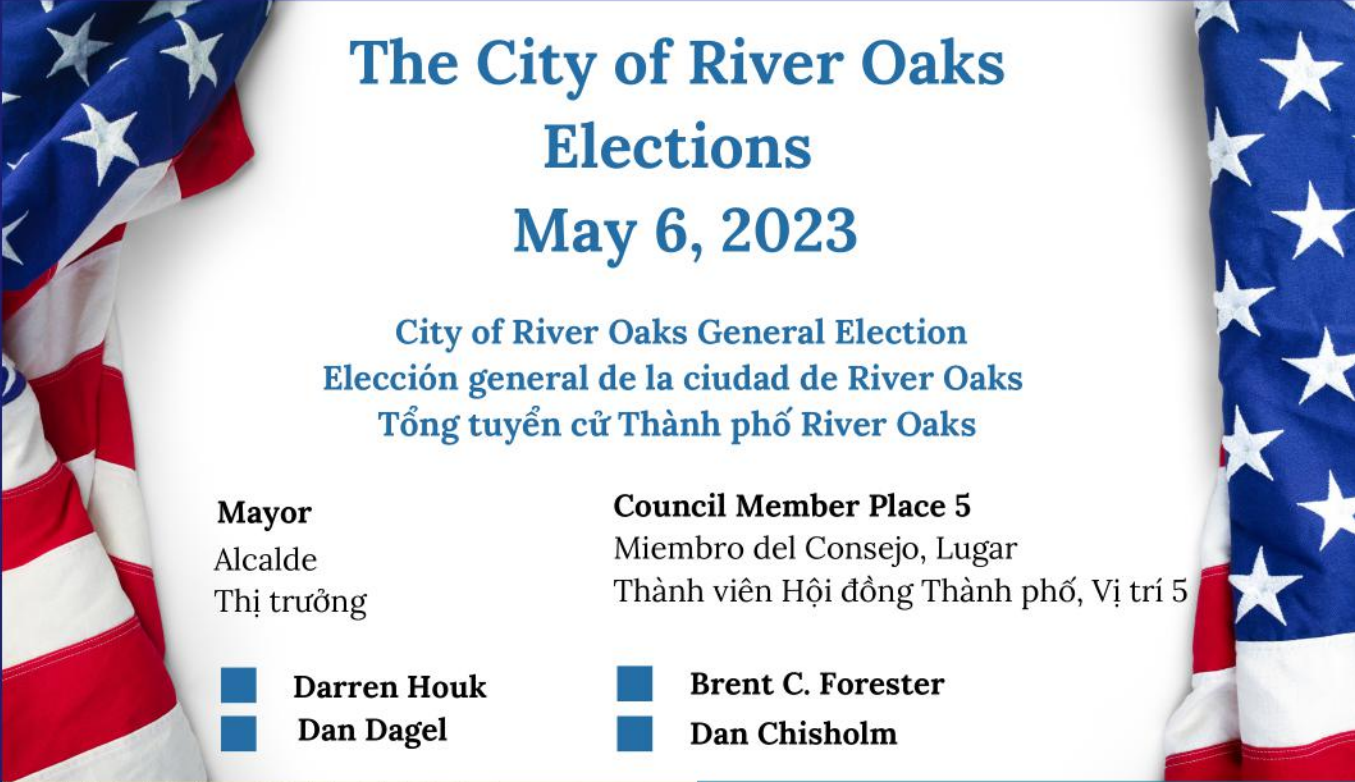

### GET RID OF THOSE OLD DISCARDED TIRES

Discarded tires laying around in the yard is a source of mosquito breeding. Put those old, discarded tires out at the street curb each week on Wednesday and the city will pick them up and get rid of them for no charge to you. This offer is good from March 1, 2023 until April 30, 2023, so take advantage of the special free collection service while it lasts. Please limit the number of tires to be discarded at any one time to no more than 4 used discarded tires. Where there are more than 4 tires, please contact the Public Works Department to schedule a special pickup at 817-626-5421 Extension 332. Otherwise, Citizens can call for pickup or else public works will pick up tires when placed on curb. This service is for residential customers only. The City will not collect tires disposed of from businesses since commercial collection is under contract with a commercial waste hauler.

### Special Notice: Storm Debris Collection

The City Sanitation Department will collect any tree limbs and brush placed at the curb from the storm damage last week at no additional cost to the resident. The Public Works is requesting that tree Limbs and debris when stacked in a pile not to exceed twelve (12) feet in length, four (4) feet in width, and four (4) feet in height which are stacked neatly with the larger diameter of the limbs facing in one direction for easy handling. For larger piles please contact the Public Works Department at 817-626-5421 extension 332 in order to schedule a special collection.

# APRIL 1ST - APRIL 30TH

NOW IS YOUR CHANCE TO CLEAN UP YOUR PROPERTY, HOUSE AND GARAGE AND GET RID OF ANY UNWANTED REFUSE BY PLACING IT AT THE STREET CURB FOR COLLECTION ON YOUR REGULAR TRASH AND BULK PICK UP DAY.

DURING APRIL CLEAN UP MONTH THE CITY WILL PICK UP TREE LIMBS, BRUSH, LOGS, DEBRIS, JUNK, TIRES, GARBAGE, AND TRASH FROM THE CURB.

### WHAT IS ACCEPTED?

- Automotive fluids
- Batteries
- Household Cleaners and Chemicals
- Cooking Oil
- Lawn/Garden/Pool Chemicals
- Light Bulbs
- Paint and Painting supplies

### WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED?

- Ammunition & Explosives
- Appliances & Electronics
- Building Materials
- Bulk Trash and Yard Waste
- Butane/Propane Cylinders
- Medical Waste
- Tires
- Asbestos/PCBs/Radioactive items
