In 1962 President Kennedy signed Proclamation Public Law 87-726 designating May 15 as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15 falls, as National Police Week. Established by a joint resolution of Congress in 1962, National Police Week pays special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty while protecting life and property. We must never forget that 800,000 law enforcement officers nationwide risk their lives every day for our safety and protection. Last year, 264 of those men and women did not make it home to their families at the end of their shift. This year 119 officers have died in the line of duty. Please take time to recognize your River Oaks police officers, they are on duty to protect and serve all River Oaks residents.
