**SEC. 5.08.002 PROHIBITED**  
IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY FOR ANY PERSON TO MANUFACTURE, ASSEMBLE, STORE, TRANSPORT, RECEIVE, KEEP, SELL, OFFER OR HAVE IN THEIR POSSESSION WITH THE INTENT TO SELL, USE, DISCHARGE, IGNITE, DETONATE, FIRE OR OTHERWISE SET IN ACTION ANY FIREWORKS OF ANY DESCRIPTION. THE PRESENCE OF ANY FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY IN VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE.

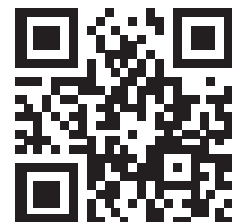
