Barbara Road Street Improvements Starting July 18

Tarrant County will start the road construction project on Barbara Rd in phases starting with Phase 1 from Roberts Cutoff to Merritt starting Wednesday July 18th, 2023. RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SERVICE ***UPDATES***



Residents are now able to purchase trash cans an put them at the curb on garbage days. All household garbage must be put either in plastic bags or boxes not exceeding 55 pounds in weight placed at the edge of the street or as an option in garbage cans placed at the edge of the street not exceeding 32 gallons in size and must be removed from the street curb by 7:00 A.M. of the following day.





All brush and tree limbs shall be limited to one (1) pile per lot on each residential customer account when stacked in a pile not exceeding twelve (12) feet in length, four (4) feet in width, and four (4) feet in height which are stacked neatly with the larger diameter of the limbs facing in one direction for easy handling and will be collected on Wednesday twice a month beginning Wednesday, August 2, 2023 as designated by the Public Works Director.
