## Utility Ordinance Updated

### City Council voted to update River Oaks Code of Ordinance Sec. 13.02.039 Reconnection

Water utility customers who are disconnected due to non-payment and pay online must call the Water Department to be reconnected.

Someone over the age of 18 must be available to sign the affidavit to be reconnected.

When the customer calls the Water Department or comes in person and requests reconnection; they are advising staff they will be available to sign the affidavit. If the customer does not answer when city staff arrives at the property they will be left a door tag.

The customer will have a \$15 service fee added to the account per time city staff goes out to the property to reconnect after the first attempt.
