AUSTIN - The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) is responding to Texas Governor Greg Abbott's directive this week to work with local partners and federal intelligence agencies on heightened public safety measures in light of the recent attacks against Israel.

The department encourages Texans to remain vigilant at all times and report any suspicious activity via iWatchTexas.

The iWatchTexas program is a critical resource for reporting suspicious activity in communities across the state in order to help prevent dangerous attacks. Tips can be reported via the website, the free iOS or Android mobile app or by calling 844-643-2251. All reports are confidential. Remember, iWatchTexas is not for emergencies. If there is an emergency, call 911 immediately.

For the 10th year, MedStar is offering to take one or two children out for Halloween in a very special Fort Worth neighborhood. This program is designed for kids who might not normally be able to go trick or treating due to medical restrictions.





The child will be picked up at home, brought to a specially selected neighborhood in a fully decorated MedStar ambulance. The child and their family will be escorted through a specially selected neighborhood on one of our stretchers, with full medical support, until their goody bag is full!

Nomination deadline is Monday, October 16th

Participation Guidelines:

- Date of event will be October 29th, between 6p and 9p.
- Child and parents should live or be temporarily residing in the <u>MedStar service area.</u>
 - Children in a hospital, or other medical facility are eligible, and we will coordinate with the facility to determine feasibility.
- Child should be between 5 and 15 years old.
- Child and parents should be willing to share their experience with media partners and sign a media release.
- MedStar shall make the final determination of clinical appropriateness for participation.

Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on it.
