The Project will consist of the following:

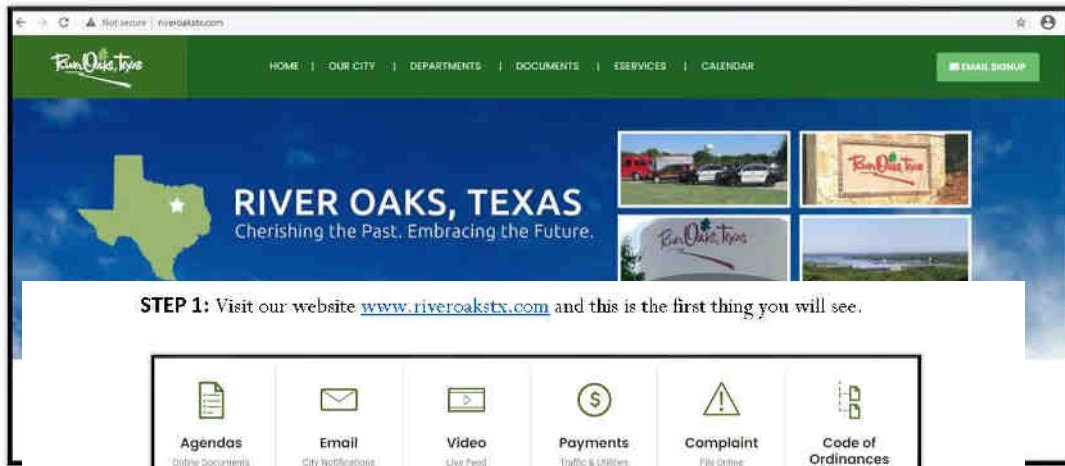
The City of River Oaks intends to remove damaged road and replace the new asphalt.

Texas Pro Construction and the City of River Oaks will start street improvements on Long Avenue on October 25, 2021. The construction is estimated to take 4 days.

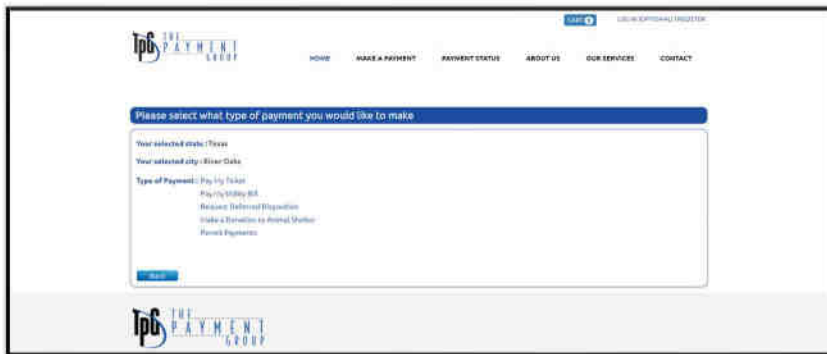
Residents in the work zone will not have vehicle access to their driveways; once, the new street improvements are finished residents driveways will be accessible.

## Step-by-Step how to: Web payments



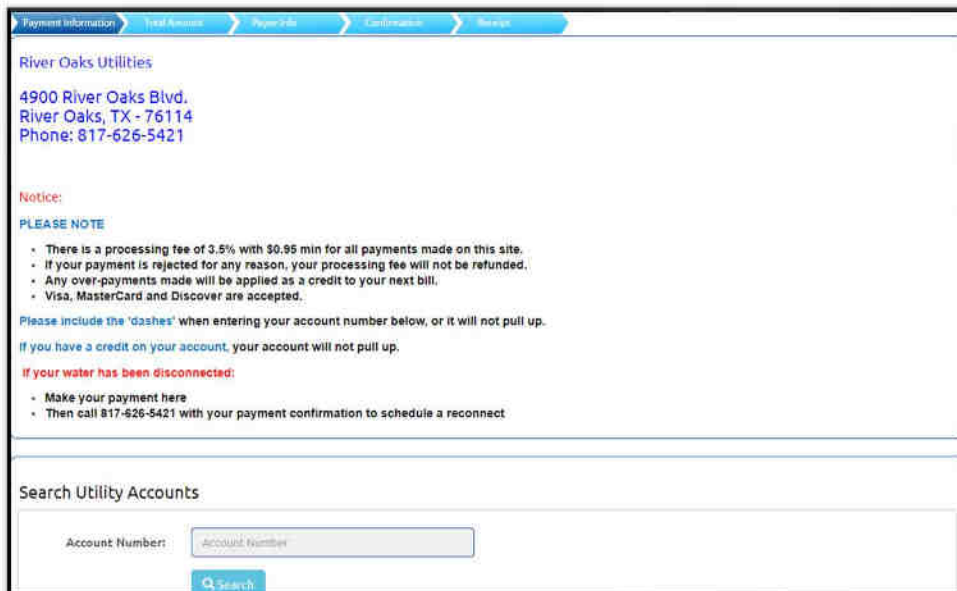
STEP 2: On the home screen, you will see this task bar mid screen, click on PAYMENTS.
