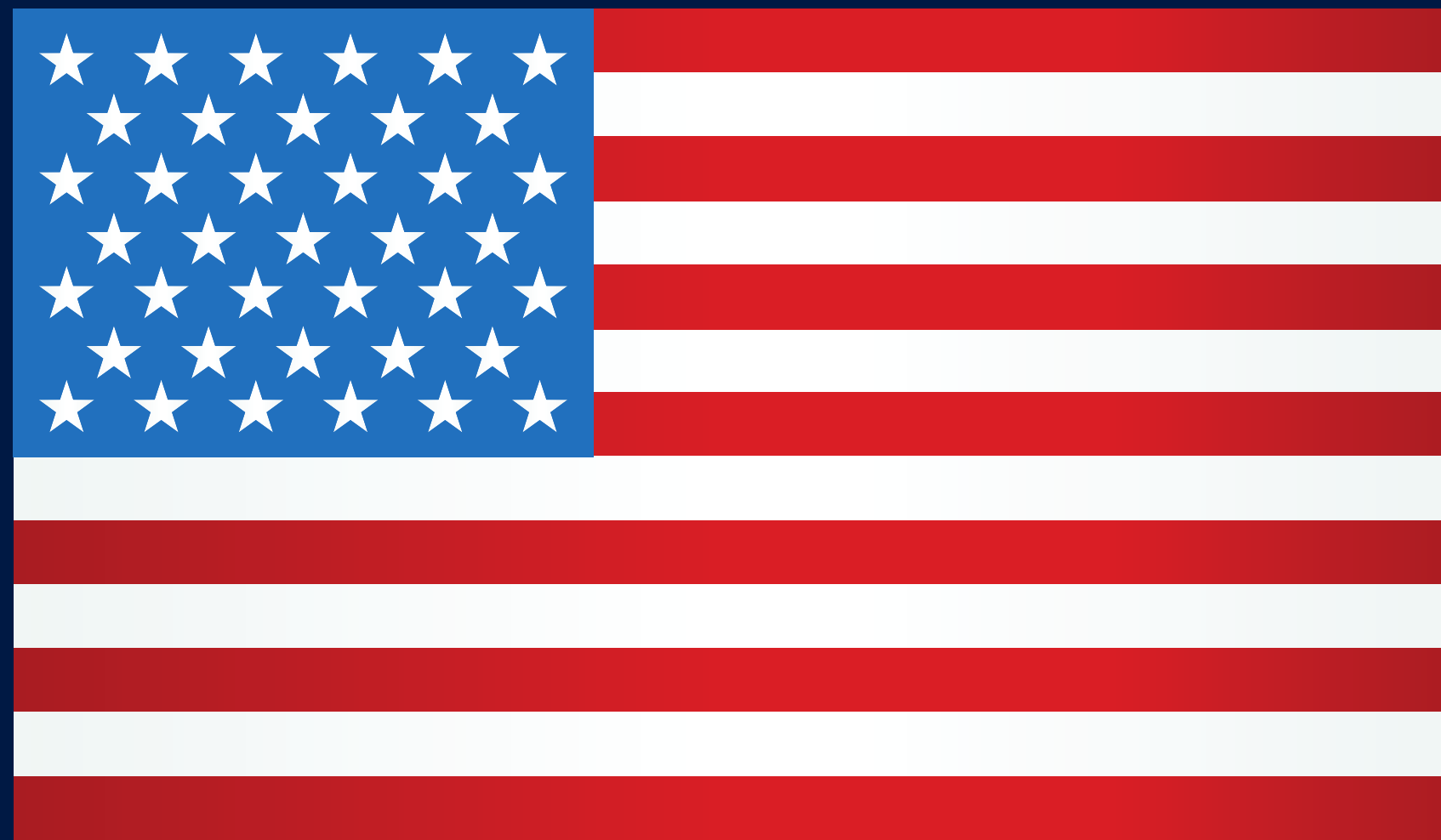

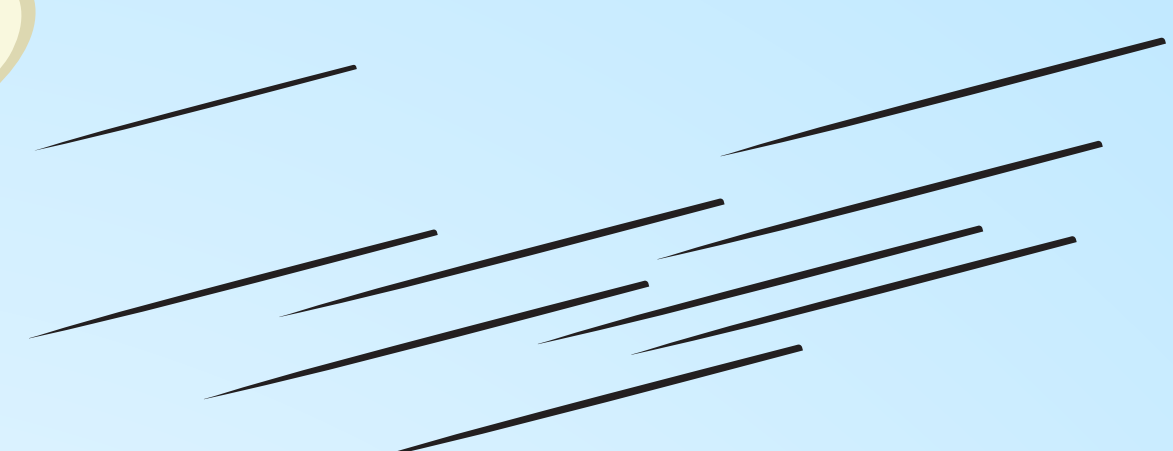

PROTECT YOURSELF, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY

- DUMP STANDING WATER IN AND AROUND YOUR HOME BY EMPTYING AND SCRUBBING ALL OUTDOOR CONTAINERS SUCH AS POOLS, TOYS, PLANTERS, BIRDBATHS AND TRASH CONTAINERS.**
- TIGHTLY COVER WATER STORAGE CONTAINERS SUCH AS BUCKETS, CISTERNS AND RAIN BARRELS SO THAT MOSQUITOES CANNOT GET INSIDE TO LAY EGGS.**
- CLEAN OUT GUTTERS TO AVOID STANDING WATER. EXAMINE GUTTERS FOR DAMAGE THAT WOULD CAUSE WATER TO COLLECT.**
- INSPECT YOUR YARD AFTER EVERY RAINFALL AND EMPTY ANY CONTAINERS OR AREAS WHERE WATER HAS COLLECTED. ALSO, WATCH FOR PUDDLES WHERE CONDENSATION GATHERS FROM THE AC UNIT.**
- USE SCREENS ON WINDOWS AND DOORS AND REPAIR HOLES IN THE SCREENS.**
- APPLY INSECT REPELLENT ANYTIME YOU'RE OUTSIDE, AND USE INSECT REPELLENT WITH ONE OF THESE ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: DEET, PICARIDIN OR OIL OF LEMON/EUCALYPTUS OR OTHER EPA-APPROVED REPELLENT.**

River Oaks Food Bank

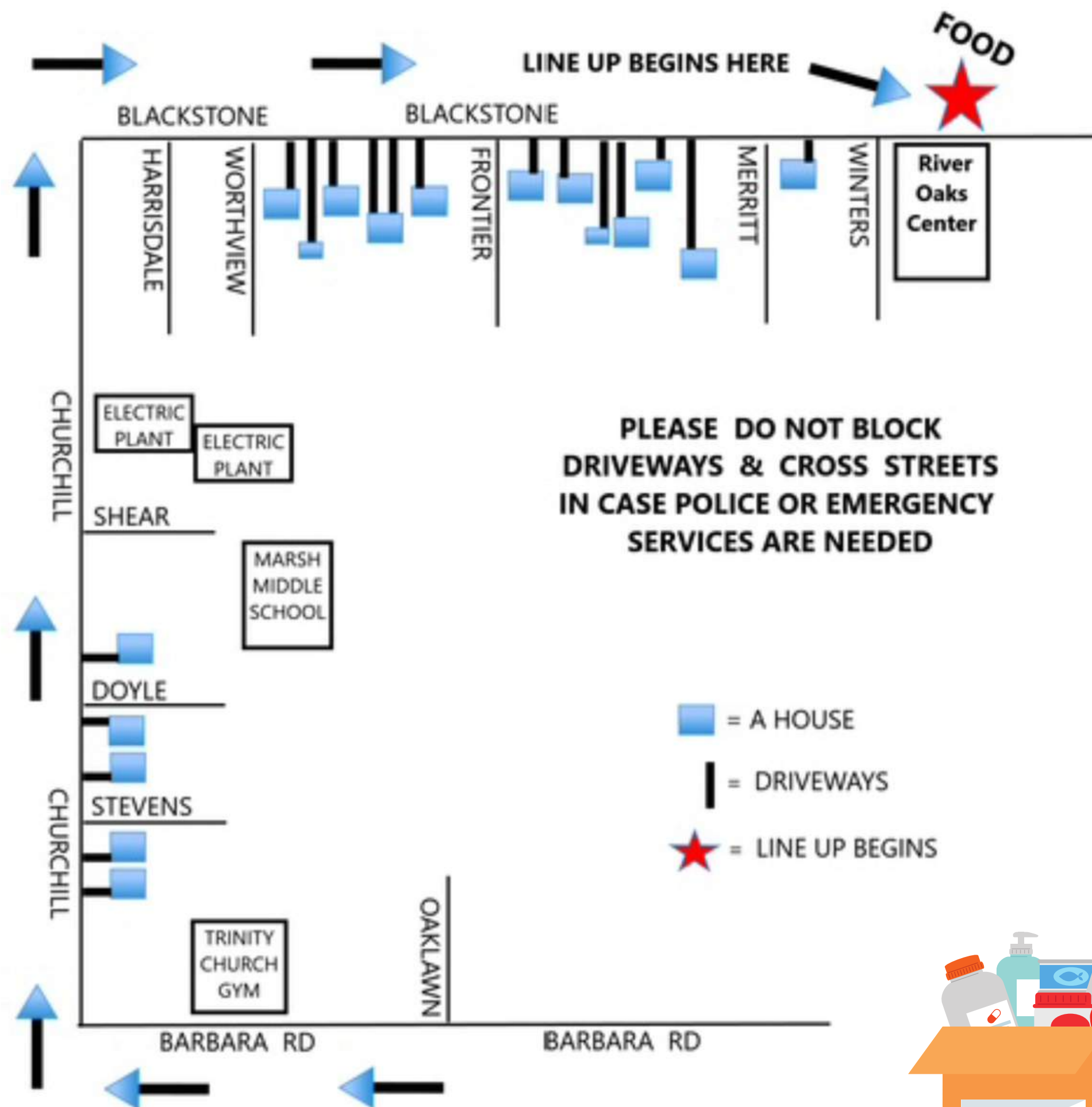
Our Food Banks are held the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month.

YARD SALES

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year. Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You may purchase up to 3 additional directional signs at \$1 each. Signs must be picked up within 24 hours of the end of sale or fines may be issued. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on the ID and the Yard Sale Permit must be purchased 24 hours before the sale. To have your Yard Sale placed in the weekly Newsletter, you must have purchased your Yard Sale Permit prior to 4:30 pm on Thursday the week of your sale.
