You can pick up the application packet at the River Oaks City Hall or it will be posted on the website www.riveroakstx.com. All applications MUST be completed and turned in by 5:00pm on February 14, 2020.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS OF OFFICE:**

Each person who becomes a candidate for Mayor or councilmember shall meet the following qualifications:

- 1. be at least twenty-one (21) years of age on the date of the election or date of appointment;
- 2. be a citizen of the United States:
- 3. be a qualified vote[r] of the city;
- 4. reside and have resided for at least twelve (12) months preceding the election day within the corporate limits of the city;
- 5. no candidate may file for more than one office or position number per election.
- 6. Not have been convicted of a felony for which he or she has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
- 7. Not have been deemed mentally incompetent by a final judgement of court.
- 8. Also, you must be able to attend council meetings 2 times a month at 7:00pm, attend special council meetings and budget meetings.
