CALL TO ORDER

The meeting started at 6:00 P.M.

The introduction to the meeting was given by Dan Kessler, Assistant Director of Transportation. Mr. Kessler gave a brief background of Meandering Road which is proposed to be a 4 lane road that is 53' wide.

Eric Greenman with Lamb-Star gave a presentation about the roundabouts. Lanes will be 11' wide; there will be a 5' bike lane on both sides; and there will be a 6' sidewalk on one side and a 10' sidewalk on the other side. There were several things that were taken into consideration when mapping the roundabouts: crossing, merging and diverging. With this proposition, there would only be 10 conflict points in comparison to 29 on the existing intersection. There was a traffic comparison done, and with the proposed roundabouts, there will be a 0-2 second delay in traffic and it would eliminate crashes (making them less severe and less crashes period). Construction will take 12-18 months. At this time, the audience asked questions and the questions were answered.


