CALL TO ORDER

The meeting started at 6:03 P.M.

PWD Gordon Smith gave an update on the infrastructure improvements under the TWDB Funding Program:

Phase 1 Water-Bid was awarded to Excel 4 Construction. Project began March 2019 and is scheduled for 365 construction days. Notices will be issued to each resident on the projects prior to any construction. The project on Churchill is complete except for minor clean up that remains. Currently on River Oaks Blvd, a 12" water main is being installed from Ohio Garden to Churchill. The project will consist of replacing 20,450 feet of water mains. The streets remaining are: River Oaks Blvd, Ohio Garden, Robert's Cut Off, Shady Oak, Club Oak, Schieme, Asbury, Sam Calloway, Makarwich Court and a section tie in at the Merritt/Hassett intersection.

Phase 2 Sewer-Bid was awarded to IPR Construction. Project began June 2019 on Taylor Street. This project consists of 25,262 feet of line, 87 manholes, and 405 services reconnects. The remaining streets affected are Thomas (which will start about July 9th), Club Oak, Shady Oak, Roberts Cut Off, Barbara Road, Blackstone, James, Andrea Court, Schieme, and a section of River Oaks Blvd.


PWD Smith briefly went over the revised Annual Water Quality Report.
