DISTANCE LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAMS (DLS)

If you opted for virtual learning this semester, the Y's Physical Distancing Enrichment Program can help keep your children socially engaged during the school year, while still receiving the benefits of online learning. While school may look a little different this year, the Y is here to help bring some fun and enrichment to your child's day.

SCHOOLS SERVED: Camp Carter distance learning is available to elementary students K and up from the Eagle Mountain Saginaw and Castleberry ISD's.

HOURS: Monday - Friday; Full Day Week: 7am—6pm

DAILY SCHEDULE: Your child's daily schedule will vary to meet the needs of their virtual learning experience. Our staff will assist children with daily classwork, calls and assignments.
