The lunch will be at Italianos in their back room. The board picked March 26th for the luncheon.

According to our City Attorney, the city owns the building, and the city will maintain it. The General Fund never reimbursed EDC for this property. All rental income is deposited into the General Fund and all expenses come from the General Fund.
