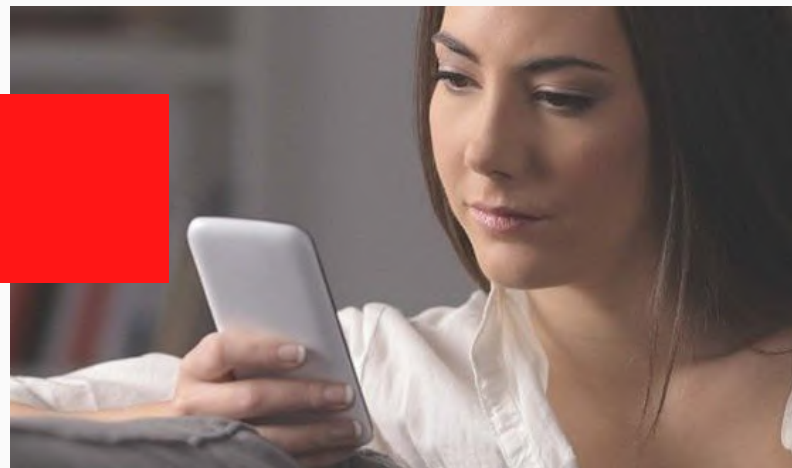


CODERED
