Cover your plants before the cold weather arrives to help retain some heat. Bring sensitive plants indoors.



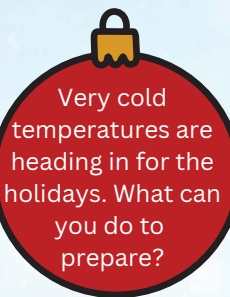
### Protect Your Home

# Residential Winter Sewer Averaging

Each year the City of River Oaks averages the water consumption of the December, January, and February billing periods to recalculate sewer charges. These months are used because typically residents do not have a high outdoor water demand and are considered to be the lowest overall water use. The new winter sewer average goes into effect on the March billing and that will be the new monthly sewer charge for the next twelve months.
