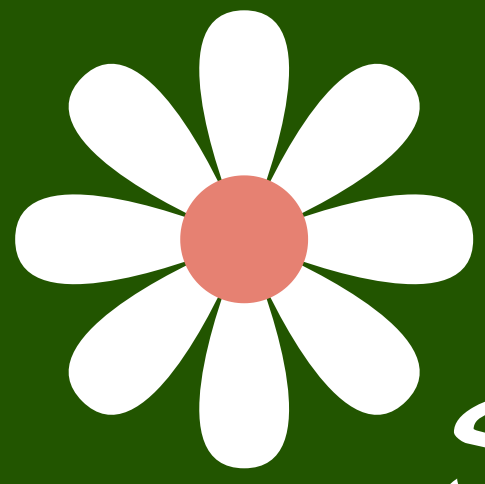

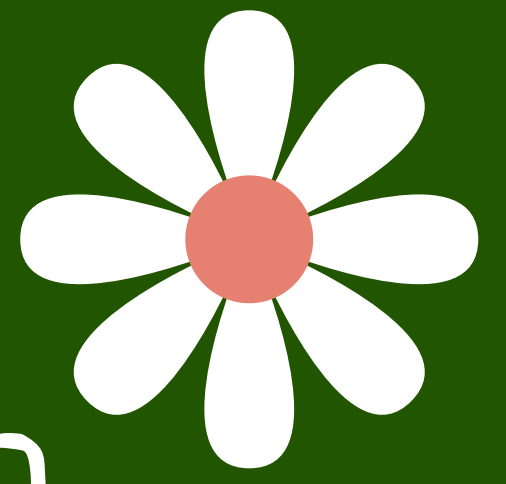

All fences shall be maintained in a safe condition and in good repair.

Whenever the fence, or any portion thereof, because of dilapidation, deterioration or decay or from any other cause is likely to partially or completely collapse, the property owner shall repair, replace or remove the substandard fence within 30 days from the date of notice.

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year.

Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs.

You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address.

You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on it.
