Siding, shingles and other exterior parts must be in good repair. interior walls, ceilings, floors and other structures must be in sound condition. Electrical, heating and plumbing fixtures must meet minimum standards.

BUILDING NUMBERS & ADDRESSES

numbers must be placed in a position so as to be plainly visible from the road fronting the property.

FENCES

Approved fencing materials must be used and kept in good repair.

OPEN STORAGE

Equipment, materials, or furnishings that would ordinarily not be used outdoors may not be stored outdoors.

JUNK, TRASH & DEBRIS

Such items are prohibited from being left in the yard and must be disposed of properly.

OVER GROWN WEEDS & GRASS

Yard maintenance pertains to any untended growth in excess of 10 inches,

JUNK VEHICLES

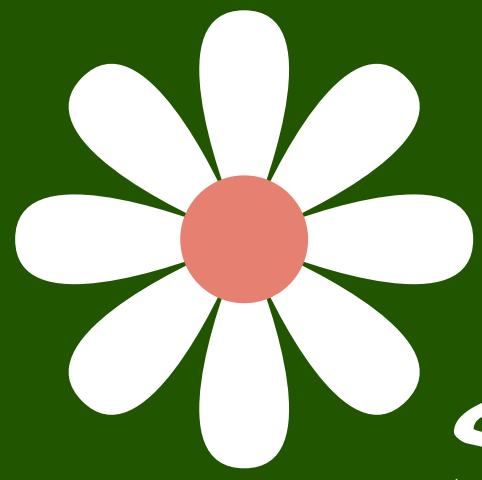
Vehicles must have a current license tag, be equipped with all parts required to legally and safely operate on public streets and can be driven under it own power.

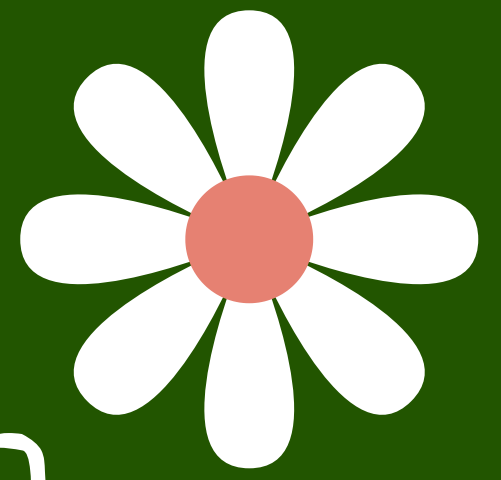

NOW IS YOUR CHANCE TO CLEAN UP YOUR PROPERTY, HOUSE AND GARAGE AND GET RID OF UNWANTED REFUSE BY PLACING IT AT THE STREET CURB FOR COLLECTION ON YOUR REGULAR TRASH AND BULK PICK UP DAY.

DURING APRIL CLEAN UP MONTH, THE CITY WILL PICK UP: TREE LIMBS, BRUSH, LOGS, DEBRIS, JUNK, TIRES, GARBAGE, AND TRASH FROM YOUR CURB.

TIRES WILL BE COLLECTED MARCH 1ST THROUGH APRIL 30TH.

PLACE THE TIRES IN A SEPERATE PILE NEXT TO YOUR REGULAR TRASH. DISCARDED TIRES LAYING AROUND ARE A BREEDING GROUND FOR MOSQUITOES.

Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on it.
