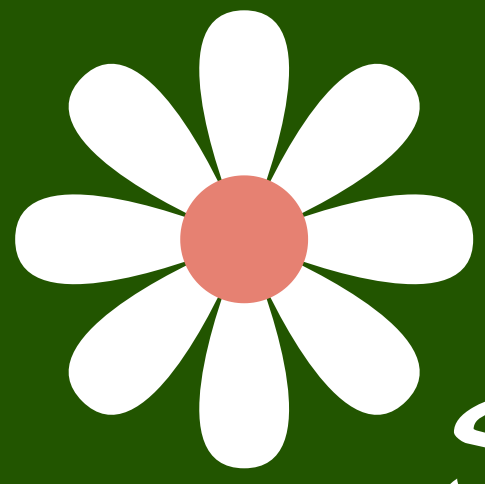

Time During The Spring And Summer Months.**

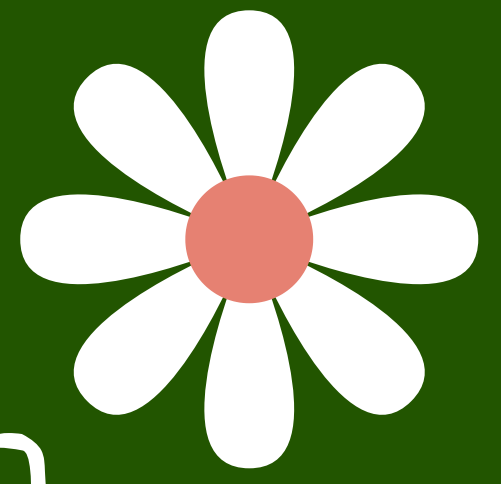

NOW IS YOUR CHANCE TO CLEAN UP YOUR PROPERTY, HOUSE AND GARAGE AND GET RID OF UNWANTED REFUSE BY PLACING IT AT THE STREET CURB FOR COLLECTION ON YOUR REGULAR TRASH AND BULK PICK UP DAY.

DURING APRIL CLEAN UP MONTH, THE CITY WILL PICK UP: TREE LIMBS, BRUSH, LOGS, DEBRIS, JUNK, TIRES, GARBAGE, AND TRASH FROM YOUR CURB.

TIRES WILL BE COLLECTED MARCH 1ST THROUGH APRIL 30TH.

PLACE THE TIRES IN A SEPERATE PILE NEXT TO YOUR REGULAR TRASH. DISCARDED TIRES LAYING AROUND ARE A BREEDING GROUND FOR MOSQUITOES.

Leave products in original, marked containers (no trash bags). If unlabeled, please label contents. DO NOT transport chemicals in the passenger compartment of your vehicle. Place items securely in the trunk of your car or truck bed.

Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs.

You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address.

You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on it.
