



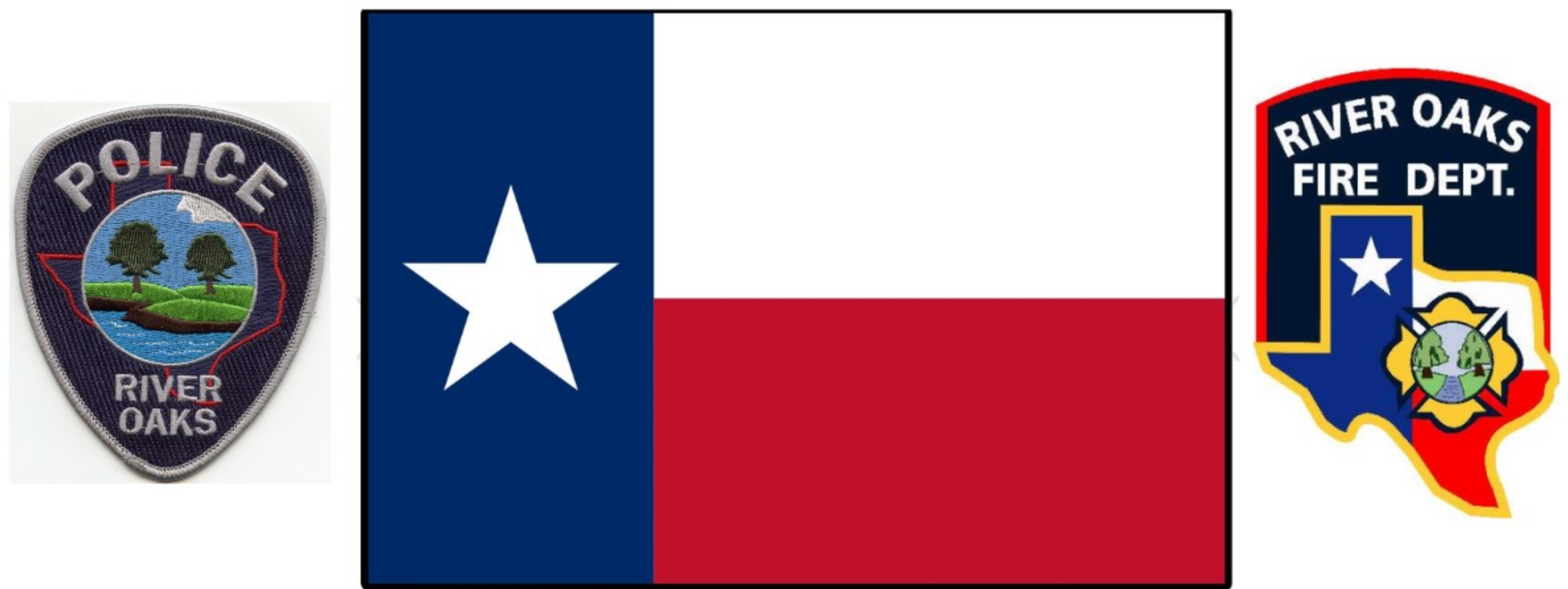

Council Adopts 2023 Tax Rate At \$0.660210/\$100 Property Value



CITY OF RIVER OAKS ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE; THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 0.495721 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$2.87

Help Us Keep Leaves Out Of The Streets

Leaves and other landscape debris need to be bagged and placed at the curb for Wednesday pick-up along with your bulk items!

Keeping leaves and debris out of our storm water drainage ways is a top priority. Keeping them free and clear for storm water run-off rain events.

Under NO circumstances should you or your landscaper ever sweep, rake, or blow leaves into the street. This is a violation of the River Oaks discharge code MS4 prohibited 13.10.017 (d) and violators can be fined up to \$2,000 for each offense.

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year.

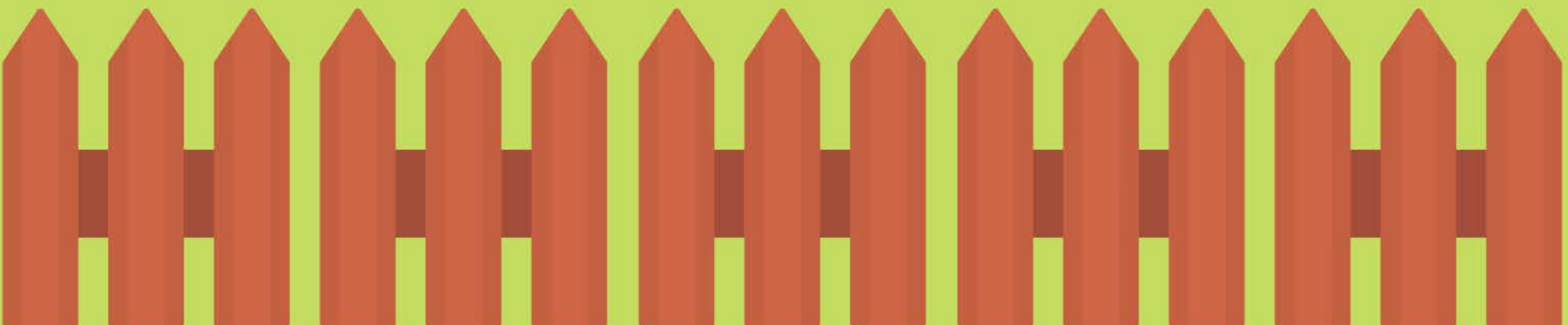
Yard sale permits are \$10 each.
