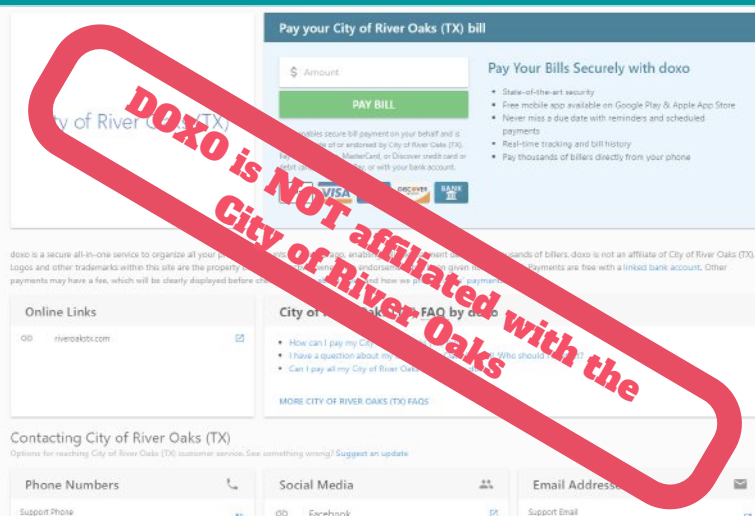

WHAT IS DOXO?

DOXO is a third-party online bill payment website that allows the general public to pay utility bills online through the DOXO website. They are not affiliated in any way with River Oaks Utilities.

WHY IS DOXO NOT A GOOD THING?

DOXO on-line bill payment website appears to be affiliated with a water system or municipality, but it is not. "doxo.com" may charge extra fees, and River Oaks cannot control when our utility will receive payments from doxo.com, possibly resulting in a late payment fee or disconnection due to non-payment. Therefore, The City of River Oaks advises customers to ONLY utilize the BILL PAYMENT tab on our website for online bill pay.

Tax Free Weekend

SALES TAX HOLIDAY IS AUGUST 6TH - 8TH, 2021



During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Comptroller encourages all taxpayers to continue practicing social distancing and support Texas businesses while saving money on tax-free purchases of most clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks (sold for less than \$100) during the annual Tax-Free weekend. Qualifying items can be purchased tax free from a Texas store or from an online or catalog seller doing business in Texas. In most cases, you do not need to give the seller an exemption certificate to buy qualifying items tax free.

This year's sales tax holiday begins Friday, Aug. 6, and goes through midnight Sunday, Aug. 8.

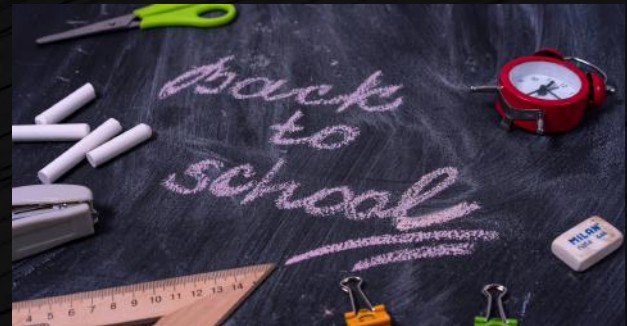
The sales tax exemption applies only to qualifying items you buy during the sales tax holiday. Items you buy before or after the sales tax holiday do not qualify for exemption, and there is no tax refund available.

Online Purchases and Telephone Orders

To promote social distancing, the Texas Comptroller's office wants all taxpayers to know that during the Tax-Free Weekend, you can buy qualifying items online or by telephone, mail, custom order or any other means (including in-store purchases) tax free, when either the item is both delivered, and paid for, by the customer during the exemption; or the customer orders and pays for the item, and the seller accepts the order during the exemption period for immediate shipment, even if delivery is made after the exemption period ends.

A seller accepts an order when the seller has acted to fill the order for immediate shipment.

An order is filled for immediate shipment regardless of whether the shipment is delayed due to a backlog of orders or because stock is currently unavailable to, or on back order by, the seller.

Description

- Read water meters and perform service orders
- Performs various duties using hand tools such as picks, shovels, rakes, pipe wrenches and other assorted hand tools.
- Operates power tools such as chain saws, cement mixers, water pumps, pipe saw, drill motors, air compressors, tapping machine, other gas powered equipment and other hydraulic tools
- Able to learn to operate heavy equipment such as backhoes, dump truck, skid loader, sewer machine and front end loaders
- Learn to repair service line leaks and main breaks
- Able to use power jet machine for cleaning and unstopping sewer mains
- Learn to properly backfill all excavations
- Set up barricades and road blocks when working around vehicular traffic
- Perform the repair and construction of pipe installations
- Assist street and sanitation department when necessary



Requirements

- Able to read digital meters and perform service orders that include check for leaks, repair leaks, rereads.
- Assists Water Department in repairing service and main line leaks
- Functions closely with all employees of the public works department
- Works closely with the Street Dept. in repairing street cuts and asphaltting
- Works in and around open excavations in the street due to water/wastewater repairs to lines and appurtenances
- Receives work assignments from the Utility Superintendent and/or his/her supervisor
- To protect the public safety at all times
- Follow safety rules especially concerning working in and around vehicular traffic
- File daily reports of work performed with the superintendent and/or Public Works Director.

Our current Animal Control Officer is out on medical leave for the next several months. We are looking for an experienced Animal Control Officer to work with the city covering Animal Control Duties on a part time basis working 10 to 15 hours a week with very flexible scheduling options.

Salary

ACO part time salary will be \$16.00 hour. This is a temporary part-time position and not eligible for City of River Oaks employee benefits.

Requirements

Required Education and/or Experience

High school education or G.E.D.; three to six months related experience or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Certificates, Licenses, Registrations

TX Class C driver license minimum with good driving background

Must possess both a Texas Department of Health Basic Animal Control Officer Certification and a Euthanasia Certificate issued by the Texas Department of Health.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Duties include, but are not limited, to:

- Safely and humanely capture and transport animals including those that are sick, injured or potentially dangerous.
 - Respond to calls for animal assistance from law enforcement, report and observe emergency situations and animal law violations.
 - Investigates the reporting of animal bites, and dangerous/vicious animals.
 - Document filed notices from an investigation of pet/property owner and records data on appropriate forms/logs.
 - Issue citations for animal code violations related to all City ordinances and state laws.
 - Track the progress of violations and compliance.
 - Properly clean and maintain an assigned vehicle, equipment, and tools to ensure proper working order.
 - Patrol the City streets and roadways, search for stray dogs and other domestic animals and livestock.
 - Maintain animal holding facility at the River Oaks Animal Shelter.
 - Complies with all applicable department security and safety rules, regulations and standards pertaining to vehicles and personal safety.
 - Performs other duties as assigned.
 - Convey a positive professional image by action, communication, and appearance.
- Maintain regular attendance.

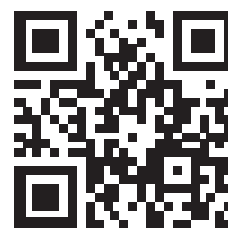
