### **WATER CONSERVATION**

All water users.

- (A) Maximum of twice per week watering for hose-end sprinklers and automatic irrigation systems based on odd/even addresses and day of week schedule.
- (B) Stage 1, water watch, outdoor watering schedules:
- (i) Monday. No outdoor watering; water system recovery day.
- (ii) Tuesday and Friday. Nonresidential sites; apartments, parks, common areas, HOA's, businesses.
- (iii) Wednesday and Saturday. Residential addresses ending in even numbers; 0, 2, 4, 6, 8.
- (iv) Thursday and Sunday. Residential addresses ending in odd numbers; 1, 3, 5, 7, 9.

"doxo.com" may charge extra fees, and River Oaks cannot control when our utility will receive payments from doxo.com, possibly resulting in a late payment fee or disconnection due to non-payment. Therefore, The City of River Oaks advises customers to ONLY utilize the BILL PAYMENT tab on our website for online bill pay.

# Tax Free Weekend

SALES TAX HOLIDAY IS AUGUST 6TH - 8TH, 2021





During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Comptroller encourages all taxpayers to continue practicing social distancing and support Texas businesses while saving money on tax-free purchases of most clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks (sold for less than \$100) during the annual Tax-Free weekend. Qualifying items can be purchased tax free from a Texas store or from an online or catalog seller doing business in Texas. In most cases, you do not need to give the seller an exemption certificate to buy qualifying items tax free.

This year's sales tax holiday begins Friday, Aug. 6, and goes through midnight Sunday, Aug. 8.

The sales tax exemption applies only to qualifying items you buy during the sales tax holiday. Items you buy before or after the sales tax holiday do not qualify for exemption, and there is no tax refund available.

#### **Online Purchases and Telephone Orders**

To promote social distancing, the Texas Comptroller's office wants all taxpayers to know that during the Tax-Free Weekend, you can buy qualifying items online or by telephone, mail, custom order or any other means (including in-store purchases) tax free, when either

the item is both delivered, and paid for, by the customer during the exemption; or

the customer orders and pays for the item, and the seller accepts the order during the exemption period for immediate shipment, even if delivery is made after the exemption period ends.

A seller accepts an order when the seller has acted to fill the order for immediate shipment.



#### Requirements

Required Education and/or Experience

High school education or G.E.D.; three to six months related experience or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

#### Certificates, Licenses, Registrations

TX Class C driver license minimum with good driving background

Must possess both a Texas Department of Health Basic Animal Control Officer Certification and a Euthanasia Certificate issued by the Texas Department of Health.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Duties include, but are not limited, to:

- Safely and humanely capture and transport animals including those that are sick, injured or potentially dangerous.
- Respond to calls for animal assistance from law enforcement, report and observe emergency situations and animal law violations.
- Investigates the reporting of animal bites, and dangerous/vicious animals.
- Document filed notices from an investigation of pet/property owner and records data on appropriate forms/logs.
- Issue citations for animal code violations related to all City ordinances and state laws.
- Track the progress of violations and compliance.
- Properly clean and maintain an assigned vehicle, equipment, and tools to ensure proper working order.
- Patrol the City streets and roadways, search for stray dogs and other domestic animals and livestock.
- Maintain animal holding facility at the River Oaks Animal Shelter.
- Complies with all applicable department security and safety rules, regulations and standards pertaining to vehicles and personal safety.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- Convey a positive professional image by action, communication, and appearance.
   Maintain regular attendance.
