

**ORDINANCE # 1231-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS AMENDING THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR WATER FUND BUDGET DUE TO AN UNPLANNED EXPENDITURE INVOLVING FIRE DEPARTMENT GAS SENSORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** on September 4, 2018 the City Council of the City of River Oaks, Texas approved Ordinance No. 1198-2018, adopting the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** due to the unplanned expenditure that was the result of gas sensors on the fire truck failing and needing to be replaced in order for the fireman to test the inside of a structure for the presence of dangerous gases before entering said structure ; and

**WHEREAS,** given the fact that gas sensors on the fire trucks are no longer serviceable, it necessitates that be replaced: and

**WHEREAS,** the Fire Chief recommends that the gas sensors would be through a lease program rather than outright purchasing them and therefore recommends entering into a monthly lease with Specialized Response Solutions at a cost of \$581 a month; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council after a thorough research of the budget determined that this unplanned additional expenditure be funded by expanding the FY 2018 General Fund Budget an additional \$3,000 in order to cover the monthly lease for the remainder of the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS:**

**SECTION 1.**

That the 2018-2019 Budget of the City of River Oaks is hereby amended by an additional **\$3,000 dollars** from the unappropriated balance of the **General Fund** and increasing the following account as follows:


**SECTION 2.**
