ORDINANCE # 1306-2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS AMENDING THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2020 the City Council of the City of River Oaks, Texas approved Ordinance # 1290-2020, adopting the operating budgets of the City for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the public works director presented at the March 4, 2021 Parks Board Meeting two quotes to add a 12-foot tall fence that is 58 feet in length across the property between the basketball goals and Greenbrier that would provide a safety barrier with the lowest of the quotes being \$4,545.00 by Allied Fence; and

WHEREAS, the parks board by a vote of 3-0 recommended approval of the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on March 9, 2021 after a thorough research of the budget found that the only available resource with the funds necessary that the Parks Board could reasonably make this unplanned expenditure without further impacting the current general fund budget was in the Park Dollar Donation Fund with a then available balance of \$22,075.71 and therefore city council deemed it a suitable expense of dollar donation funds for the parks board and determined that the Budget be amended increasing the unappropriated balance of the 2020-2021 general fund budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS:

SECTION 1.

That the 2020-2021 Fiscal Budget of the City of River Oaks is hereby amended, thereby increasing the unappropriated balance of the **2020-2021 Fiscal Year budget** in order to offset the expenditures from the Park Dollar Donation Fund as provided for below:
