### **Street Construction Update Notice 10/20/2022:**

#### **Roberts Cutoff: from Skyline to Fritz Allen: OPEN FOR THRU TRAFFIC**

Tarrant County Asphalt Crews completed the asphalt reconstruction on 10/19/2022. Staff is scheduling the Center Line markings and will have the information in the next update.

#### **Roberts Cutoff: from Ohio Garden to Skyline Dr.:**

Atmos Gas is currently installing new gas mains and services. Project is scheduled for 4 months.

#### **Merritt St: from Barbara to River Oaks Blvd:**

Atmos Gas has completed the gas main and services upgrades. Tarrant County Road Crews are pulverizing and cement stabilizing the road base for preparation of new asphalt. The section from Barbara to Black Oak is currently closed to thru traffic.

#### **Monday October 24, 2022:**

**Merritt from Black Oak to River Oaks Blvd will be closed to thru traffic also. Black Oak at the intersection of Merritt will remain Open.**

#### **Long Street: From River Oaks Blvd to Jacksboro Hwy.**

Atmos Gas is currently installing a new gas main and services. City Staff will be contracting a new water main from Thurston to Woodlawn. A grant was awarded, and staff is working with engineer on the design. City Staff is also working on designing Curb-n Gutter replacement. Once all completed, the street will be reconstructed. Future updates and schedules will be provided.

#### **Barbara Rd. from Roberts Cutoff to Isbell:**

Atmos Gas is currently installing a gas main and services. Barbara is scheduled for street reconstruction improvements in first quarter of 2023.

#### **Black Oak St : from Roberts Cutoff to Sam Calloway:**

City completed a sewer main upgrade project October 19, 2002. Atmos gas is designing new sewer main upgrades in the area. Once completed it is scheduled for street reconstruction improvements.
