

Sanitation (Garbage Collection):

Residential Trash Pick Up: All household garbage must be put either in plastic bags or boxes not exceeding 55 pounds in weight placed at the edge of the street or as an option in garbage cans placed at the edge of the street not exceeding 32 gallons in size and must be removed from the street curb by 7:00 a.m. of the following day to avoid being in violation that may result in a citation being issued by the city's code enforcement department.

Residential Bulk/Brush Pick Up: Brush and bulk pick up on Wednesday for residents. All brush/tree limbs should be piled in one pile no more than 12ft in length by 4 ft in height and 4 ft in width, if the pile is bigger than the given size it is subject to additional charges, brush will not be picked up until the invoice is paid in full. Brush/tree limbs should be separated from any other trash or bulky items.

Construction Material Pick Up: boards should be stacked separate from any brush/limbs, bulky items and regular trash. The pick-up for construction material is on Wednesdays. The city asks that you remove all screws/nails from the boards to protect the workers picking them up. All construction piles should be 2 ft in width, 2 ft in height and 4 ft in length, any pile bigger than the given size is subject to additional charges construction debris will not be picked up until invoice is paid in full. The City does not pick up concrete, due to the concrete damaging the trucks.

Pick-Up Days:

Residential south of River Oaks Blvd:

- Monday and Thursday for regular trash.
- The 1st and 3rd Wednesday of every month for brush, bulk and construction materials

Residential north of River Oaks Blvd:

- Tuesday and Friday for regular trash
- The 2nd and 4th Wednesday of every month for brush, bulk and construction materials
