



### Indoor Furniture

River Oaks Code of Ordinance 6.03

Any furniture whether new or secondhand not approved for outdoor use including, but not limited to mattresses, bedroom furniture, dining room furniture, upholstered furniture, home office furniture, entertainment centers, and infant and youth furniture, shall not be stored in public view.



### Junk and Debris

River Oaks Code of Ordinance 6.03

Rubbish, brush, junk or other unsanitary or unsightly matter, including, but not limited to waste, trash, garbage, refuse, appliances, building materials or machinery shall not be allowed to accumulate or be present upon the property.

Violation of an ordinance or regulation that governs fire safety, zoning or public health and sanitation including those listed herein may result in a fine of up to two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) per occurrence.

### **Yard Parking**

River Oaks Code of Ordinance  
Zoning Article 14 Sec 20.17 A

Parking of any automobile, bus, truck, motorcycle, motor home, camper, trailer, boat or vehicle on grass or a surface other than a hard surface is not allowed.



### **High Grass**

River Oaks Code of Ordinance 6.03

Grass, weeds, or any plant that is not cultivated shall not be allowed to grow to a height greater than 10 inches in the front, side or rear yards, on the land or between the property line of the land and the curb.



### **Trash out Early**

River Oaks Code of Ordinance  
13.02.113(1)(E)

Garbage is not to be placed at the curb earlier than 6:00 p.m. the day before scheduled collection day.

Trash cans are not allowed.

Voluntary Recycling is Wednesday. All items must be in a transparent, blue recycle bag. Please sign up at the Water Department to receive the list of accepted items.

The city sanitation department will not dispose of hazardous or toxic wastes, tires, petroleum products, paints, construction materials, insecticides and any other wastes that are not household generated.
