CALL TO ORDER

The meeting started at 6:00 P.M.

PWD Gordon Smith gave an update on the infrastructure improvements under the TWDB Funding Program. In the Water Main Replacement Phase I project, 20,450 feet of water mains are to be replaced. The streets affected are: River Oaks Blvd, Churchill, Ohio Garden, Robert's Cut Off, Shady Oak, Club Oak, Schieme, Asbury, Sam Calloway, Makarwich Court and a section tie in at the Merritt/Hassett intersection. The water infrastructure improvements design is waiting on approval from the TWDB and once approved the city will go out for bids and construction should start shortly thereafter.

On the sewer side 21,990 feet have been installed and overall 413 homes are now on new sewer mains. The contractor currently has asphalt crews working on Purdue and Yale.

PWD Gordon Smith updated the Meandering Road Project. The Design Engineer and the City of Fort Worth were present. Discussed was the existing conditions, the project overview, the Yale roundabout, and the Meandering roundabout. A timeline was presented for this project.

PWD Smith and the City of Fort Worth answered several questions from the audience about the sewer and water improvements and the Meandering Road Project. With that all thanked everybody for coming. The PowerPoint presentation of the meeting is herein enclosed as an attachment to these minutes.
