The City of River Oaks commenced construction on May 7, 2018 for major improvements on their sanitary sewer collection system. These improvements will address the replacement of the existing old sanitary sewer collection lines throughout the City. This first phase of construction will consist of approximately 2,246 linear feet of 12 inch diameter sewer lines, 37,353 linear feet of 8 inch diameter sewer line, 661 individual sewer services and 113 individual sewer manholes.

IPR SOUTH CENTRAL LLC. is the General Contractor and in the month of May completed installation of 6,926 feet of new main and 137 homes reconnected to new sewer mains. Also completed installation of 14 new manholes.

The following streets are completed with the installation of the new sewer mains final cleanup and street repairs remain:

AMHERST AVE., LANGLEY RD., PURDUE AVE., WHITE OAK LN.,
LYDICK LN.

Robert's Cutoff has a temporary lane closure that is expected to last 3 weeks. IPR has a company that will monitor and keep the barricades in place during the closure. The Closure is needed to allow safety for construction and the traveling public.
