**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting started at 6:00 P.M.

Clint Hoover, Project Manager with the City of Fort Worth was present and went over the Meandering Road project and answered any questions from the audience.

PWD Gordon Smith gave an update on the infrastructure improvements under the TWDB Funding Program. In the Water Main Replacement Phase I project, 20,450 feet of water mains are to be replaced. The streets affected are: River Oaks Blvd, Churchill, Ohio Garden, Robert's Cut Off, Shady Oak, Club Oak, Schieme, Asbury, Sam Calloway, Makarwich Court and a section tie in at the Merritt/Hassett intersection. The water infrastructure improvements design is expected to be approved this week from the TWDB and once approved the city will go out for bids and construction should start shortly thereafter.

On the sewer side 28,783 feet have been installed and overall 549 homes are now on new sewer mains. The contractor currently has asphalt crews working on Red Oak, Merritt and Yale.

On the Churchill Road water main and sewer project in conjunction with the City of Fort Worth, water and sewer lines will be replaced. The project is in the design phase.


