**CALL TO ORDER**


The meeting started at 6:00 P.M.

The plan is for three roundabouts at JG Barret, Yale and Roberts Cut Off. This project will be paid for by federal funds. It will be at no cost to the City of Fort Worth and the City of River Oaks.
