1. CALL TO ORDER

3. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MARCH 7, 2011 MEETING

Member Butler moved, seconded by Vice-President Crews to approve the minutes of the meeting on March 7, 2011 as presented. All voted "Aye".

4. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF 2^{ND} QUARTER FINANCIAL REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011 ENDING MARCH 31, 2011

CS Gregory explained that the sales tax revenues had been miscalculated by \$4,449 that would be paid to the general fund from the EDC account. Much discussion occurred related to the calculation of sales tax. Council directed CS Gregory to research the calculation process and report the findings to the Board.

CS Gregory reported that the beginning balance was **\$81,569.57** in the bank and **\$224,513.65** in Texpool. For the 2nd quarter, EDC received **\$34,585.27** in revenues and expended **\$60,459.52** for an ending balance of **\$55,695.32** in the bank. EDC received **\$83.40** in interest for the Texpool account for a total ending balance in Texpool of **\$224,597.05**. The ending total bank and Texpool balance is **\$280,292.37**.

Vice-President Crews moved, seconded by Member Butler, to approve the 2nd quarter financial report ending March 31, 2011 as presented. All voted "Aye."
