He can continue to serve as Place 4 Council Member until the office is filled by a Special Election. Candidate filing for Place 4 begins on January 29, 2020 and ends on March 3, 2020.

Our building code effectiveness grade based on the recent evaluation moved from a class 4 up to a 9 with 4 being good. The main reason for the fall was due to us operating under the 2012 International Codes. By adopting the 2015 International Codes, our rating would go back to class 4. Agenda Items #16-24 will need to be approved in order to operate under the 2015 International Codes.

Currently we have to dig thru several boxes in storage to get past records on vehicles. The cost is \$3,000.00 per year and will include updates.
