CM Gregory reported the beginning balance for the 3<sup>RD</sup> quarter was **\$101,251.96**; sales tax for the quarter totaled **\$61,444.05**; interest from the bank was **\$17.35**; vest reimbursement was **\$1,200.00** resulting in total revenues of **\$62,661.40**. Total expenditures for the quarter of **\$37,023.44**-yielding an ending balance of **\$126,889.92**.

Member Ashton moved, seconded by Member Chisholm to approve the 3<sup>RD</sup> quarter report. All voted "Aye".

Revenues are \$227,700.00. Expenditures are \$198,737.00 which includes a new clerk position in the Police Department to help with paperwork, etc. The current Police Secretary who is also the dispatch supervisor, the workload for her has extremely increased.
