## **ORDINANCE # 1186-2018**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS AMENDING THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR WATER FUND BUDGET DUE TO AN UNPLANNED EXPENDITURE INVOLVING WATERLINE IMPROVEMENTS EXPENDING FUNDS FROM WATER RESERVES IN ORDER TO REPLACE 240-FEET OF WATER MAIN INCLUDING SERVICES AND APPURTENANCES IN THE TRUMAN RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE 5400 BLOCK OF TRUMAN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** on September 5, 2017 the City Council of the City of River Oaks, Texas approved Ordinance No. 1162-2017, adopting the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018; and

**WHEREAS,** due to the development of property in the 5400 block of River Oaks Blvd. involving infrastructure improvements in the Truman Dr. Right-of-Way under the control of the City of River Oaks, it necessitates that the old deteriorated water main be replaced; and

WHEREAS, there was no funding budgeted in the 2017-2018 Water Fund in order to replace the water line including service lines and appurtenances therefore, the City Council after a thorough research of the budget determined that this unplanned additional expenditure be funded by expanding the FY 2018 Water Fund Budget an additional \$26,340.00 in order to cover the costs associated with the construction involved in replacing 240-feet of new water main, services and other appurtenances within the Truman Dr. Right of Way and that the Budget be amended increasing the unappropriated balance of the 2017-2018 budget.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS:

## **SECTION 1.**

That the 2017-2018 Budget of the City of River Oaks is hereby amended by an additional **\$26,340.00 dollars** from the unappropriated balance of the **Water Fund** and increasing the following account as follows:
