iSWM Program Benefits and Incentives:

Local governments that achieve Bronze, Silver, or Gold iSWM Implementation may be entitled to a series of benefits that are being considered by the iSWM Implementation Subcommittee:

- Providing free training to iSWM communities and their designated design consultants
- Offering more classes for a larger municipal audience, such as planners
- Providing classes at communities' offices
- Providing plaques to be displayed in communities
- Providing signage at city entrances designating a community's level of iSWM implementation
- Planning an annual banquet or forum for iSWM members, to present program highlights, awards, and discussions can be offered
- Using a separate industry event, such as the TFMA North Texas Luncheon, to present program highlights, awards, and discussions
- Providing documents such as flyers for communities to include in utility mailers, particularly documents that may assist in MS4 requirements
- Adopting these higher standards will provide credits towards a lower FEMA Community Rating System (CRS) rating, equating to reduced insurance rates for your community's residents
