1. Call to Order:

David Ballard - the Vice- Chairman called the Meeting to Order at 6:33 pm.

- a. April 3 Meeting minutes Warriner made the motion to approve the minutes, Brooks seconded the motion. All Aye.

- 4. Report from Council Liaison Joe Ashton Ashton was absent.
- 5. Discussion and/or Action on the recommendation to the council regarding planned improvements at Coates Park.

 - b. Chairman Makarwich will discuss with the City Council regarding removing the thirteen (13) Chinese pistachios trees that are crowding and stunting the growth of the Live Oak Trees.
 - c. Plan to trim the Live Oaks, Carolina Buckthorns and the barrier of bushes (Date to be determined).
 - d. We will seek advice in advance of cutting the trees, with Steve Winters or other knowledgeable tree specialists.
- 6. Discussion and/or Action regarding request from Sandra Michaels for providing fields for Youth Soccer.
 - a. Norma Cumberledge attended the meeting on Wednesday, April 30 with Sandra Michaels, James Myrick and others at St. Elisabeth's Church located at 5910 Black Oak Lane in River Oaks.
 - b. Raydon Inc., provided the proposal/estimate to build three (3) Soccer fields behind the Church. (Proposal is attached, see last page of this document). The Total cost = \$40,580.00.
 - c. Sandra Michaels will approach the National Diocese, Lions Club, Fort Worth Soccer, YMCA, area businesses regarding possible funding and sponsorship of this project.

- d. The members of the Park Board addressed other details/expenses/concerns...
- 1. Who would maintain the fields? Cost involved to maintain the fields?
- a. The Youth soccer Committee was inquiring regarding what kind of assistance the City of River Oaks can provide with field maintenance/water expense?
- 2. How many years would the fields be available?
- a. Would LYSA run the program?
- b. RE: could City lease the field at the St. Elisabeth's Church for \$1.00 a year (Since the church can not sale the lots.

Note: LYSA did at one time run a Soccer program. The program was cut because LYSA did not have the fund to pay for renting of the soccer fields. If we did have an active Soccer Program, LYSA's registration fees would provide the uniforms.

- a. Consider having a soccer camp or some other event to create interest and gauge the community's support for a youth soccer program.
